While we hear so much in the media advocating the views of the Gay Lobby on Same Sex Marriage, very little is heard about why it is so important to protect traditional marriage for the sake of the family.

The 95% of ordinary Australians who are not gay have an equal right to protect the maintenance of the existing definition of marriage enshrined in Australian law as exclusively between one man one woman voluntarily entered into for life.

From the very beginning God instigated a covenant relationship between one man and one woman to form family as the nucleus of society¹. After Jesus was born he grew up in a traditional family² and affirmed the God ordained nature of marriage between one man and one woman for life³.
